



# John Cox Beginnings

## Part 1

All major events in the Cox family occurred within one hundred miles of London. The major roads in their towns, the surplus of their farm products, the commerce in their cities all pointed to London. John Cox Senior eventually ended up in Teddington, a city on the Thames River in a London suburb. Yet his beginnings were in a quiet village less than one hundred miles southwest of London.

John Cox Senior was born 17 September 1813 at Pewsey, Wiltshire, England, the son of William Broad and Mary Cox. Wiltshire is the location of the ancient Druid civilization in England. The Druids may have migrated across the channel from the Celtic people in Europe and stayed in the

mild climates of Wiltshire and Ireland. Because the Druids are said to have been in Britain 3,000 years before the time of Christ, there are several references to them in Roman literature. However, since they had no written language and left no artifacts to explain what they believed, little is known about

them. Various references and traditions show they may have practiced human sacrifice, believed in reincarnation, and held oak trees and mistletoe sacred. It is not known how or why the Druids built Stonehenge and the Great Stone Circle at Avebury in the County of Wiltshire, but they remain to this

day monuments to an ancient and somewhat mysterious civilization.

Wiltshire County with its easy access to the sea and its mild climate was the center of considerable history and folklore in England. Almost a thousand years before John Cox was born, in the year 871, King Alfred the Great came to the English throne as king of the Anglo Saxons in Southern England. It was Alfred who was given credit

there. John Cox, growing up in Wiltshire, had to be aware of the ancient history of his home.



Stonehenge, fifteen miles south of Pewsey, was left by the Druids in pre-Christian times. It is not likely the Cox family were unaware of it.



For centuries the Wiltshire countryside has been a patchwork of tiny villages and farms divided by streams, trees and pathways.

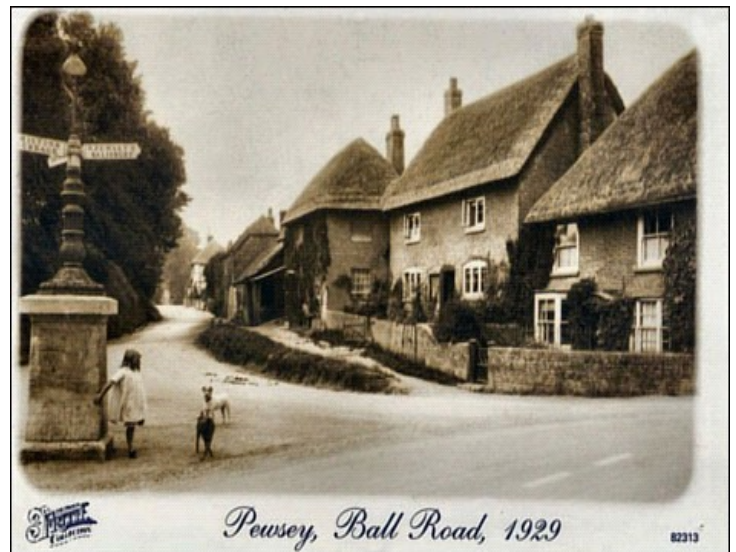

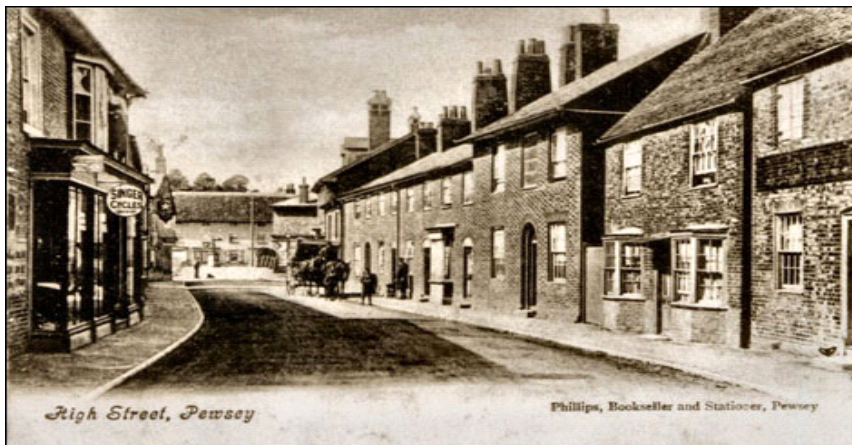

was named Elizabeth Broad.

Both the Broads and the Coxs were from Wiltshire for many generations. However, the Industrial Revolution caused so many families to move from their ancestral homes, it isn't surprising to find John's father displaced and out of work soon after his marriage. Some time before 1820 when John was about seven years old, the family moved forty miles east to Wield in Hampshire County where their last

five children were born. Wield was the location of several "yeomen," land owners with the surname Broad, who hired farm laborers.

They were probably relatives willing to hire William Broad and his sons.

John Cox grew up and married Ann Baker in Wield; and his own eight children were born there. He never owned land as did his Broad relatives; rather was listed as a farm laborer in the census. Wield may have been a quiet village, but it was only a few miles north of the city of Winchester made famous by the Norman invasion in 1066. It would have been a walk of less than five miles to see the great Winchester Cathedral, the

earliest of the great cathedrals in England.

Wield seems isolated until one remembers it was situated directly in the center of a triangle created by the industrial city of Basingstoke, the Norman city of Winchester, and the ancient port city of Southampton. It was to Wield the Mormon missionaries came in April of 1851, and the Cox and Stiff families were baptized.

John's father and mother were alive when the Mormon missionaries came, but no one

in the Broad family was interested in the L.D.S. Church. Yet in spite of local persecution, John Cox Sr. and six of his children were baptized. While Edwin, John Jr., Sarah and Elizabeth Ann eventually emigrated to America, John Sr. moved to the bustling town of Teddington on the Thames River to work for the railroad. He died there at the age of 55 in a train accident 9 July 1869.
