> CLARK

(off skeleton)

Cam is impressed; Brennan poker-faced --

BRENNAN

What's your rationale?

CLARK

The coarse-fibered periosteal and chondroid bone masses at the osteotendinous junctions -- the anchors -- are not abrupt, indicating that the muscle mass was created gradually over time.

BOOTH approaches and regards them --

CAM

What killed him?

CLARK

The sternal ribs are subluxated at both the spine and sternum.

BRENNAN

Indicating that he was crushed?

> CLARK

More pinned, I suspect. Smothered, perhaps in an industrial accident?

BOOTH

This the guy Bones is checking out to replace Zack?

Clark Edison, meet Special Agent Seeley Booth.

> CLARK

Hey! "Bones" is what everyone called me at college. Funny, huh?

BOOTH

I like him.

(to Brennan)

You got a minute?

7 CLARK

Are you going to a crime scene? Do you need me?

BRENNAN

I'll let you know.

And she leaves. A nod of from Booth to Cam and he follows --

> CLARK

Did I get it right?

CAM

Yes. Construction worker.

Foundation collapse.

> CLARK

But I'm not impressing her.

CAM

Hard to tell, Clark. I'm still not completely certain what Dr. Brennan

thinks of me.

3 EXT. HIGHWAY - NIGHT 3

Brennan, still dressed in her lab coat, and Booth walk along the highway, past a number of dented, smoking cars. Drivers speak to cops, trying to recreate the chain of events which led to this accident --

BOOTH

Caroline, am I any more annoying

than I used to be?

CAROLINE JULIAN

I find that you maintain an impressively consistent level of annoyance at all times, why?

BOOTH

Reality check. Nothing.

The elevator doors doen and faroline steps inside --

CAROLINE JULIAN

The fact that Dr. Brennan isn't here wouldn't have anything to do with your drop in self-esteem, would it?

Thanks for the warrant.

CAROLINE JULIAN

Believe me, annoving is the least of your problems

BOOTH

Thanks.

CAROLINE TULIAN

was your decision to take that As a compliment, cher

And the doors shut.

CUT TO:

INT. MEDICO-LEGAL LAB / BONE ROOM - DAY

CLOSE ON -- AN X-RAY OF THE SKULL --

CAM (O.S.)

What am I looking at?

A finger indicates a small bone spur in the sinus --

BRENNAN (O.S.)

It's called an osteoma.

REVEAL -- BRENNAN, CAM & CLARK EDISON

(CONTINUED)

> CLARK

It's a type of bone spur that grows down from the skull down into the sinus cavity.

BRENNAN

Clark found it when I gave him the x-rays to analyze.

CAM

An osteoma that size would headaches Infected Sinuses, Maybe worse.

CLARK

Osteomas are every bit as distinctive as fingerprints or retinas.

CAM

We'll check with local ear, nose, and throat surgeons, see if the pain drove our victim to seek help. (as she goes, to Clark) Nice job.

As she leaves, Angela enters --

ANGELA

(to Brennan)

FBI forensics team just delivered about a million bone chips.

BRENNAM

-MODDA

And Booth says more to Come:

Brennan hurries off, leaving Angela and Clark --

CLARK

How are you today, Angela?

ANGELA

See how I don't look at you in the eyes? It's because I refuse to bond. Nothing personal, but I love Zack and I see nothing wrong with waiting for that stupid war to end to get him back.

CLARK

What if I only work here until the war is over?

ANGELA

Not looking. Not listening.

Angela follows Brennan. Clark sighs.

CUT TO:

INT. MEDICO-LEGAL LAB / NEAR FORENCIC PLATFORM - DAY

Brennan is just about to swipe her card when Angela stops her and pulls her to the side --

ANGELA

You're not going to hire this one **A**ither.

BRENNAN

I heven't made up my mind yet.

ANGELA

And when you don / hire him, it prolongs your lame excuse not to go out into the figld with Booth.

BRENNAN

Why would I do that?

In the b.g., Clark mounts the platform --

NGÉLA

Because when Hodgins and I ran away from our wedling we left you and Booth standing at the altar and that icomic image freaked you out.

BRENKAN

No, it didn't. \Iconic image?

ANGELA

Sweetie, this is not one of those things where you try to keep a secret and I ferret out the truth. This is where I tell you something that's true so you can catch up with your own reality!

BRENNAN

CLARK

BOOTH

Got anything human?

BRENNAN

I'll have to go through and see.

>CLARK

I could do that, Dr. Brennan.

BOOTH

Clark could do that, Bones:

BRENNAN

Too many. This could take days, even with the two of us.

BOOTH

(to Clark)

Is that true?

> CLARK

Kind of putting me in an awkward position there.

Booth looks at her, she looks back --

BOOTH

(to Clark)

Zack would have told me.

And Booth leaves. Clark looks to Brennan, who is already separating the bones.
