KAT

Here, mom, Ignatia Amara. (off Booth's expression) It's a homeopathic remedy for grief.

MANGEE

When we same home, there was a supof horbal toa on the counter, like he'd only stopped out for a minute.

Kat takes her mother's hand as she cries.

BOOTH

I noticed the fields as we drove in. You still operate the farm?

Margie nods, but she's too emotional to speak.

> KAT

No matter how big the business got, Dad wanted to remember how it all started.

DESIDINARY

And your farm... it's certified erganis, correct? No posticides other than natural predators?

TIMRGIE

Of course.

Beeth and Bronnan exchange a look.

BOOTH

Did your husband have any personal problems, recent arguments?

Margie shakes her head, but Kat looks troubled.

MARGIE

No. Everyone loved Frank.

Mom --

Margie and Booth look to the doorway and are surprised to see Kat and Charlie, the compost facility employee. Charlie holds flowers. He hands them awkwardly to Margie.

CHARLIE

Mrs. Curtis, I -- I came over to tell you and Kat how sorry I am. Gavin said he'd try to stop over later. I didn't mean to interrupt --

It's okay, Charlie. Stay.

Mom, I knew. Since high school. Charlie knew, all my classmates knew...
