



Each year, thousands of children, young adults, teachers, and librarians select their favorite recently published children's books for the International Reading Association (IRA)'s Choices annotated booklists. The latest Choices booklists of outstanding children's books for 2002 -Children's Choices, Teacher's Choices, and Young Adults' Choices – are now available, perfect for your child's summer reading.

Children's Choices presents 100 books picked by 10,000 children nationwide. Teacher's Choices presents 30 books selected by teachers, librarians, and reading specialists for their usefulness in the classroom. Young Adults' Choices presents 30 books chosen by teams of teenage reviewers. Each booklist summarizes the books presented and gives ordering information.
