Cap can be 2 - 6 inches in diameter



Mature - Veil hangs down on stalk



Immature - Veil attached hiding gills



Bulb (volva) attached below ground.

Death Cap Mushrooms

They are growing **NOW!** These were photographed in a lawn in Woodside, CA on 10/4/2010.

Do **NOT** eat these mushrooms. Dogs, children, adults, even horses can die from their toxicity. Keep your loved ones safe.

Pick Death Caps, bag them and throw them away. If ingested take mushroom remains and get medical help **immediately!**
