

## Searching

### Searching the Entire Disk:

Note you need the Search plug-in installed to be able to do this.

- Go under the "Edit" menu in Acrobat, pull down to "Search" and choose "Query".
- Click on the "Indexes" button.
- Click on "Add" and locate the index on the disk, then click on "Okay".
- Enter your keyword(s) and click on "Search".
- Once the search is complete, you will get a list of SJ issues where your word(s) were found.
- Highlight the issue and click on "View".
- The page will display and the keyword(s) will be highlighted. To see the next page the word appears, hold down the "Command" key and type "]".

(Windows users substitute "Control" for "Command")

### Other commands

- Previous page word appears — Command "["
- Next issue word appears — Shift-Command "]"
- Previous issue word appears — Shift-Command "["

### Searching within an issue:

- Go under the "Edit" menu and choose "Find".
- Enter your keyword(s).
- Click on "Find".
