Stake Assignments

-Patches for the boys in your Stake

-Lunch for the boys and leaders in your Stake

-Make copies and handout appropriate paperwork

-Reminder calls for meetings and assignments

-Turn in names of teachers for classes as soon as possible

-Attend Campout and support leaders, teachers and boys

-Follow thru with assignments

-Classes: (50 min.) 2 of each which will require two teachers and assistants. Ask them to bring sheets for scout leaders indicating what requirements were met and to be ready with ideas for the competition.

Turn names of teachers and their assistants in to Peoria North Stake ASAP. Ask teachers and assistants to identify themselves upon entering camp so we know who all is there. They may camp out there, but we will have a designated place for them away from the boys, unless they are a leader with a troop also.

Teachers need to bring all items for classes including shade and wear their uniforms.
