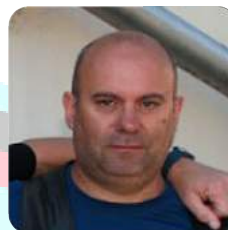

Gimjim resigned from his position as Chapter President, he left to live in Provence and returned to # 157 Provence. He is replaced by

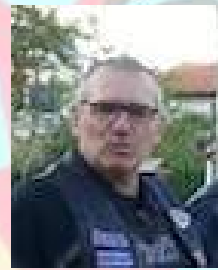
