The weather was finally sunny all day, which allowed us to rotate along the famous circuit of "Le Castellet".




ROCK FISH CAFE Reunion Island (974)






Dave BARR

Dave decides to give meaning to his life, having learned to walk on prosthetics, he learns to ride a Harley-Davidon and began self-overcoming.




Combining records distances and charitable activities for amputees veterans, he holds today to raise funds and participate in conferences.
