Dear all,

There are further conditions placed upon members of Chapter 12 which are made available to applicants on request. There is nothing sinister or onerous about these just a commitment to taking an active role as part of the Chapter and club in general rather than sitting in the background. I appreciate that this suits some people and there is nothing wrong with that at all. We would just welcome more support and assistance in our fund raising activities and also attendance at club functions which are bloody good fun.

OK, here are the beginners guides as promised. This is my attempt at a plain language description of how to get sorted on the internet. There are even pictures to help. I am working in my second language so if you have any queries, please use the e-mail contact at the bottom left of each page.

Website

Our website can be viewed at the following address. Either hold down Ctrl and click on the link below or type it into your address toolbar. http://67.15.88.60/windandfire.co.uk/ Once you get to the hompage, click on ENTER and you are in. There is a lot of information available here. There are also direct e-mail links to the Director, Secretary, Charity Officer, Webmaster and the Press Officer. There is a direct link to the International site as well. These can all be found on the Links page. There is also a guest book for visitors to sign and leave comments.


Discussion Forum

This is currently open to anyone who is a member of Wind & Fire MC. Shortly membership will be restricted to those who have been given specific permission and Chapter 12 members only. This can also be accessed directly from the Website homepage above, just below the Enter button. Either hold down Ctrl and click on the link below or type it into your address toolbar. http://windfireuk.proboards57.com/index.cgi? This will take you to a web page that has been



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started to allow us a forum to discuss subjects and issues in a simple way that allows members to leave messages for all club members to read and contribute to. When the page opens up you will see something that looks like this.

Create Account





You need to follow the instructions and enter the information requested. Your username can be anything you want but can I suggest it is something that is easy to remember like your name or nickname.

Then enter a password which must be a minimum of 6 characters long. This can be a word, all numbers, all letters or a combination of both but remember that the password is case sensitive. Write down your exact password as well so that when it comes to accessing the forum when you have registered you can remember it.

You need to use an e-mail address that you can access easily so that you can retrieve the activation key so that you can get onto the forum in the future and also activate your account. You have the option to show or hide your e-mail address and your age but both are required to allow you access in the first place.

The security check letters and numbers will be different on the real application and need to be entered correctly using upper and lower case and numbers in the correct sequence. The reason for this is to reduce the likelihood of spammers creating millions of members and flooding the site with 'ghost' members.

Once you have entered the required info, read through the conditions and then click the 'I agree button'. Once you have completed all of this click the Create Account button. You will be taken straight to the log in screen.



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Login

You need to enter your Username in the appropriate box and then your password that you wrote down earlier in the password box.

Confirmation Email Sent

An email has been sent to your_e-mail@provider.com with an activation code to activate your account. In order to use your account, you must enter the activation code that is contained in that email. Please login below, and then enter the activation key that is provided to you in the email.

If you entered the wrong email address or do not receive your activation email, you will be able to update your email address and have a new activation key sent to you after you login. If you do not receive your registration email, you may want to check your Junk Mail folder that some email providers offer, as your registration email may be there.

Then click on the login button.



You may be prompted by your system to save your password for automatic login when you access the forum in future. I suggest that you select yes unless you have your own system for remembering passwords.

I also suggest that you save the homepage into your favourites so that you don't have to keep writing in the address of the page every time you want access. You do this by clicking on the Favourites button on the top toolbar of your browser (the page you use to access the forum) then clicking on the add to favourites button and then when the screen pops up just click on OK. A quick link will then be added to your list of favourites which you will be able to access anytime from the Favourites drop down menu.

You now need to check your e-mails as the activation key will be sent to the account that you specified in the application process in an e-mail. You can access the log in screen either from the page that has popped up or by using the link in the activation e-mail that has been sent to you.

Write down the activation key or alternatively I suggest that you highlight the activation key provided and then copy and paste it into the Activation Key box as below or enter by hand using the keyboard. Then click on the Activate Account button.
