Hi Al,

I hope you have recovered from whatever was ailing you. I was hoping to get your feedback from your meeting of the 20th, so I showed up for the breakfast at Denny's, but alas.... Bob gave me his slant, but I still am curious about your reaction.

The keys to both repeater sites are now at the EOC (with Harriet). I have been informed that the EOC wants me to okay any site visits. I did not ask for this authority given both the historical access for Mac and the county vetting for you as a data maintainer. I spoke with Harriet and she has accepted blanket access for you and Mac without my prior approval (Whew!).

Mac was going to check out the ability to actually access the sites. Perhaps, you two could get together to kind of do a hand off and check out access issues at the same time. I have asked Mac to provide a list of the equipment at the various sites (to include Murdock and Englewood, so far as he knows it (and he is probably the most knowledgeable source in the county). I would like a list of the frequencies, 2 Mtr and 70Cm repeaters, radios, controllers, cans, etc., where they are located, who owns what, and what the status is. I would like to publish this information on our RACES website so that we have a permanent record.

Hope you can meet with the CARS group someday. Next Thursday will be an interesting presentation on Red Cross Communications. Hope you and anyone in your club can make it.
