LaDainian Tomlinson ran wild on Sunday before being pulled due to San Diego's huge lead. Tomlinson scored twice and rushed for 116 yards on 15 carries. Jamal Lewis pounded out the yardage in the snow on Sunday, gaining 163 yards on 33 carries and catching 1 ball for 11 yards.

"I wouldn't say we ambushed them," Forestville Bulldogs coach Valerie Archie said, "but I don't think they expected what they got."

Brandon Jacobs delivered the best yardage game of his career with 130 yards on 25 carries and 3 receptions for 30 yards. Jacobs has just two rushing touchdowns this season. Philip Rivers was able to play this week,

touchdown in three of his last four games. Anthony Gonzalez scored for the second game in a row while grabbing 7 balls for 86 yards. Gonzalez has had 6 or 7 receptions in three of last four games.

Carson Palmer was the victim of several dropped passes this week, but he still threw for 251 yards including a 52-yard score. Palmer needs 301 passing yards to hit the 4,000 mark for the season. Brian Westbrook maintained his league lead in yards from scrimmage (1,896) by rushing for 81 yards and catching 9 balls for 63 yards. Westbrook leads running backs in receptions and receiving yards.

"We can't help people out," Jersey Devils coach George Tidwell said. "We can't give them a gift when they show up."

Brett Favre set the record for career passing yards by completing 19 of 30 passes for 227 yards and 2 scores. Favre now has an amazing 61,405 passing yards in his career. Justin Fargas scored on a 2-yard run and rushed for 89 yards before leaving the game with an injury. Fargas has topped the 1000-yard rushing mark on the season (with just 7 games as the featured back).

Johnson needs 297 yards in his final two games to hit the 1000-yard mark for the season. Brandon Marshall posted double digit receptions for the second game in a row and turned in his third 100-yard game of the season. Marshall finished with 11 receptions for 107 yards.

"My presence is felt by everybody in the stadium," AB's Burn coach Alex Bryant said. "I couldn't have written a better script than what happened today."
