Hardware Installation

Each antenna is installed at the predetermined location. Each bridge is installed and connected to the appropriate antenna.

Configuration and Testing

The bridges are powered up and configured. The engineer tests connectivity between the bridges. The bridges are then connected to the network and the engineer tests connectivity between buildings through the network.

Documentation and Training

Network configuration details are documented in writing. Equipment is labeled according to your instructions. An hour of hands-on training is provided to familiarize your staff with the new equipment.
