Description

This intensive two-day course is designed for psychiatrists and clinicians, in practice and training. Focusing on its essential topics, the course will use lectures and an extensive syllabus. Topics include dementia attributable to Alzheimer disease and other conditions; anosognosia and other perceptual disorders; partial complex and other seizures, and antiepileptic drugs; pediatric neurology disorders that present with neuropsychiatric manifestations; and acute and chronic complications of antipsychotic and other psychotropic drugs.

Educational Objectives and Expected Outcome

This course is designed to prepare attendees for Boards and other examinations as well as a review of modern neurology. Attendees will also improve their diagnostic skills and be brought up-to-date in several aspects of neurologic disorders.



David Myland Kaufman, Professor of Neurology and Psychiatry at the Albert Einstein College of Medicine (AECOM), graduated from the medical school of the University of Chicago and completed training in neurology at Montefiore Medical Center / AECOM hospitals. During his residency, Dr. Kaufman originated the nation-wide course, which he still directs, "Clinical Neurology for Psychiatrists." More than 29,000 psychiatry residents and attendings have attended the course, which has served as the basis for his classic textbook, "Clinical Neurology for Psychiatrists," currently in its 6th edition and available in Italian, Spanish, and Japanese translations. Dr. Kaufman has also been a visiting professor at Ben Gurion University, numerous American medical schools and U.S. Naval Medical Centers, as well as a frequent lecturer at AECOM.



Howard Geyer received his MD and PhD degrees from the University of Pennsylvania School of Medicine. Following residency in Neurology at the Albert Einstein College of Medicine, he completed a fellowship in Clinical Neurophysiology/Neuromuscular Disease and a fellowship in Movement Disorders. He now serves as Director of the Division of Movement Disorders in the Department of Neurology at Einstein. He is very involved with neurology teaching, and has received teaching awards from residents and medical students, including induction into the Leo M. Davidoff Society.
