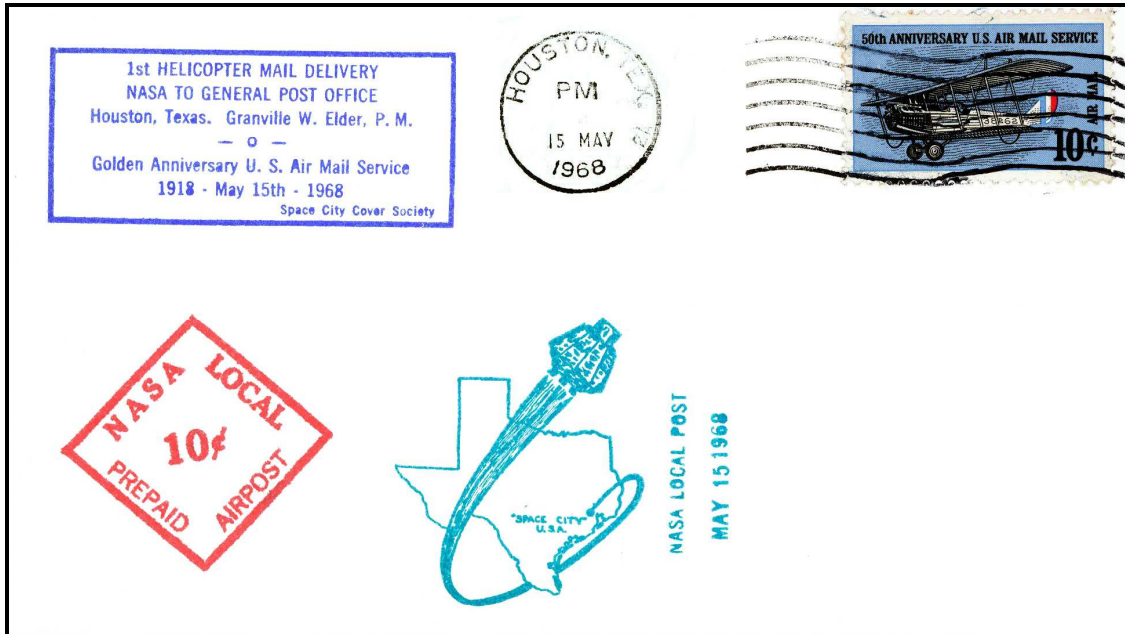


SE-11-NLP-FDC Forgery

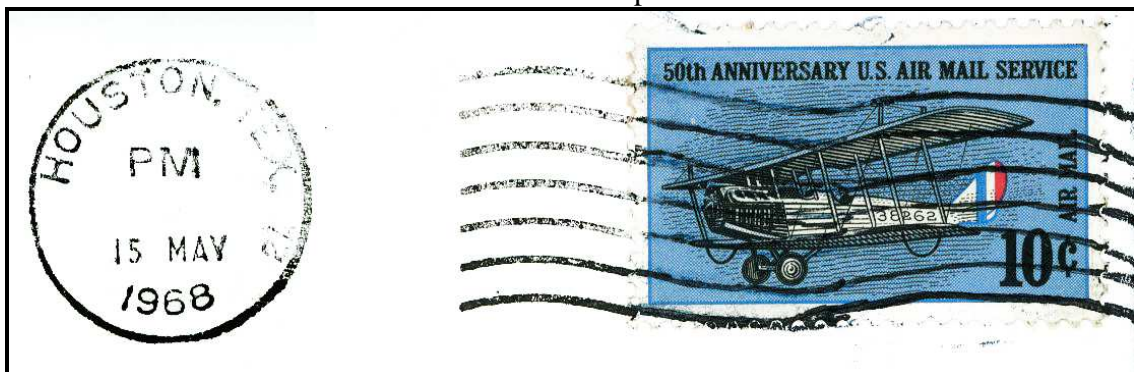
An SCCS SE-11-FDC cover was discovered in late 2013 with Scott # C74 affixed in the upper right corner of the cover. It is believed that the 750 covers produced were franked with Scott # C72, the current 10¢ Airmail stamp that was available.

The Scott #C74 stamp was released on May 15, 1968 in Washington, D.C. and also commemorated the 50th Anniversary of regularly scheduled Air Mail service. This stamp being released on May 15, 1968 would have been difficult to obtain and use on the covers to obtain the Houston, Texas cancel on May 15, 1968.
