SCENE 1

Matt Narrates:

Good afternoon my name is [Matt] and I would like to introduce you to Group Team One. [Gene, Denise, Melissa, Chris, Nick, Bob, and Liane].

One of the most important aspects of a group project is the human interaction that occurs during the duration of a project. Many things can happen. For this reason we have chose to use kids to exaggerate the difficulties that can sometimes occur within a group. Although the examples are childish they represent the idea of how difficult and important the group synergy is in order to produce results. Lets see what our group does.

[SCENE SETTING ONLY - DO NOT SAY]

The skit opens with all of us in a circle doing various things. Nick isn't in circle. Matt and Denise are playing hopscotch. Make believe sandbox in center of room. Melissa and Chris playing in sandbox and Bob and Liane are playing a game together. All of us wearing different hats: beanie, baseball cap, etc.

Nick: [COMES IN ANGRY AND ALMOST CRYING WITH ARMS FOLDED]

Gene: What's wrong Nick?

Nick: I went to play on the swings but both were taken.

Bob: Again Nick?

Melissa: That's like the third time this week.

Gene: There are not enough swings for all of us. Maybe you should try the

sliding board Nick.

Chris: Yeah, Nick, I think Gene is right.

Nick: I don't think it's very fair that we have a playground that's so small.

Denise: Liane, stop picking your nose!
Liane: Well....you guys are really boring.
Bob: Yeah, I think our playground sucks.

<u> ALL IN UNISON:</u> [Our playground does suck!]

Gene: You know what would be a great idea!

ALL IN UNISON: [What Gene?]

Gene: A BIGGER playground with more swings! Wouldn't that be cool guys?

Denise: I think it's a great idea.

Nick: Yeah, more swings so I can swing when I want to!

Melissa: How would we build it? What kind of playground and where guys? Liane: I think we should make one guys, what do you think? Can we do it?

Gene: I think we can if we can all put our heads together and come up with good

ideas but Liane you can't help unless you stop picking your nose.

ALL IN UNISON: [Yeah Liane. Its gross!!!!!]

Denise: Guys, we should make this like our "project".

Chris: A project? What's a project?

Nick: Chris, you don't know what a project is? Chris: Well, no, not really. Do you Nick?

Nick: Well...no I guess not.

IN UNISON: Denise, Liane, Melissa, Bob, Gene, and Matt

Chris & Nick [together]: Oh really, I bet none of you have any idea what you just said!!!!

Gene: It means its something we start and then finish when we are done making

it, that's all. Geez!!

Nick: So, how do you guys know all this anyway?

Bob: Well.... Mrs. Richburg told me.

Melissa: Yeah me too.

SCENE 2

Matt Narrates:

The group has decided to begin their project of building a new playground. Now they will put together the steps involved in putting this project together. There are many dynamics that go on within a group during a projects lifecycle. Each kid/person represents the different aspects of how people react when working with others. The human side of a project isn't always as easily understood as the project details may be. Lets see what happens next.

[SCENE SETTING ONLY - DO NOT SAY]

The scene opens with all of us around a table each doing our own thing. Melissa and Nick are coloring on each other's paper with crayons. Liane is putting playdoh in Bob's hair and Bob is putting it on her shoe. Denise and Chris are trying to figure out how to open the Camera and are basically fighting over it. Gene comes a few minutes later and joins the group.

Gene: Okay, guys, let's start. I haven't got all day here. I think we need to start

with a project charter. Does anyone know what that is? At least that's what

Mrs. Richburg said.

Denise: Well do we have to do everything Mrs. Richburg says just because she has

all those degrees?

Gene: Well it's the best advice I've been given Denise so lets just go with it.

Liane: Okay Bob but you gotta consider the project scope when you do it okay.

EVERYONE SAYS GOODBYE AND EXITS EXCEPT FOR GENE AND BOB

Gene: Bob I understand that you're upset because of the vote but we can work

this out.

Bob: I am not upset Gene. I don't really care anyway.

Gene: Well being a leader is not an easy job because there are a lot of

responsibilities. Maybe we can do the job together since it would be really

tough for me to do it by myself.

Bob: You want me to help you be a chief?

Gene: We could be like co-leaders. This way we can both be leaders and work

together to finish the project.

Bob: I think that's a great idea. Thanks for coming up with it. Are you sure you

don't mind?

Gene: I don't mind because I'm going to need all the help I can get. So at the

SCENE 3

Matt Narrates:

[SCENE SETTING ONLY - DO NOT SAY]

Bob: Okay guys lets get settled. Gene and I have an announcement.

Bob: All right, well Gene asked me to be co-leader with him so I wanted to ask

the rest of the group if everyone agreed with this idea.
