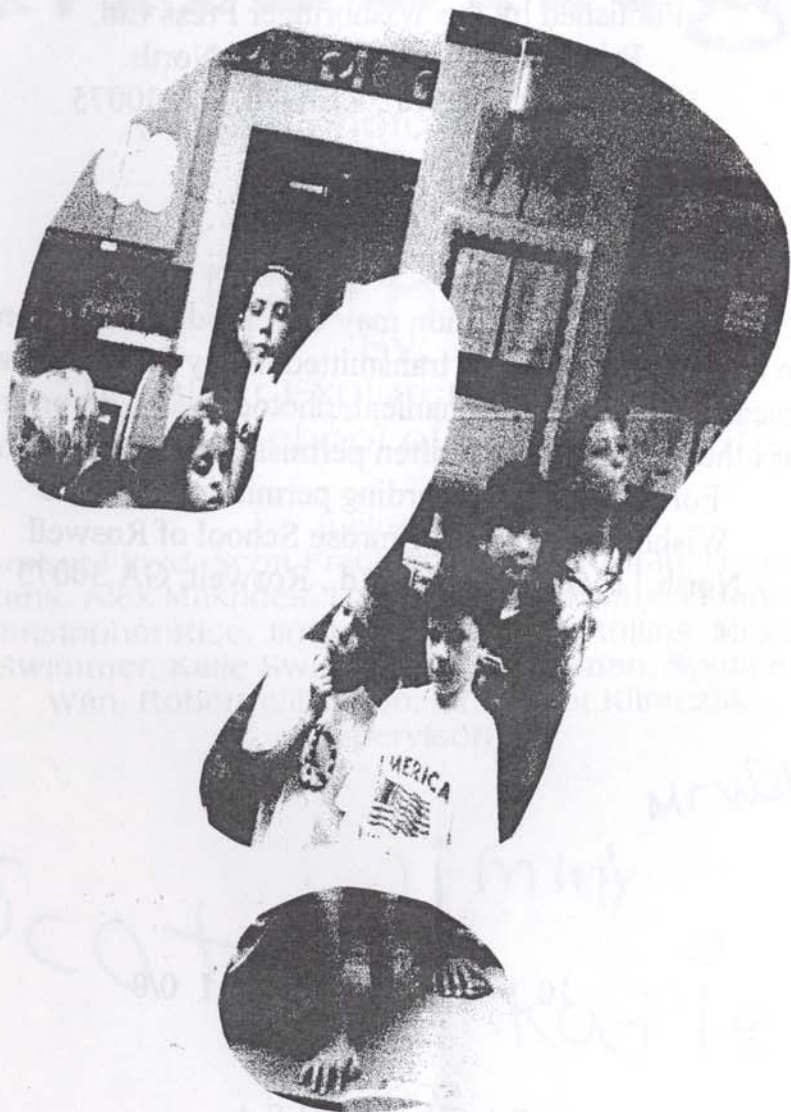

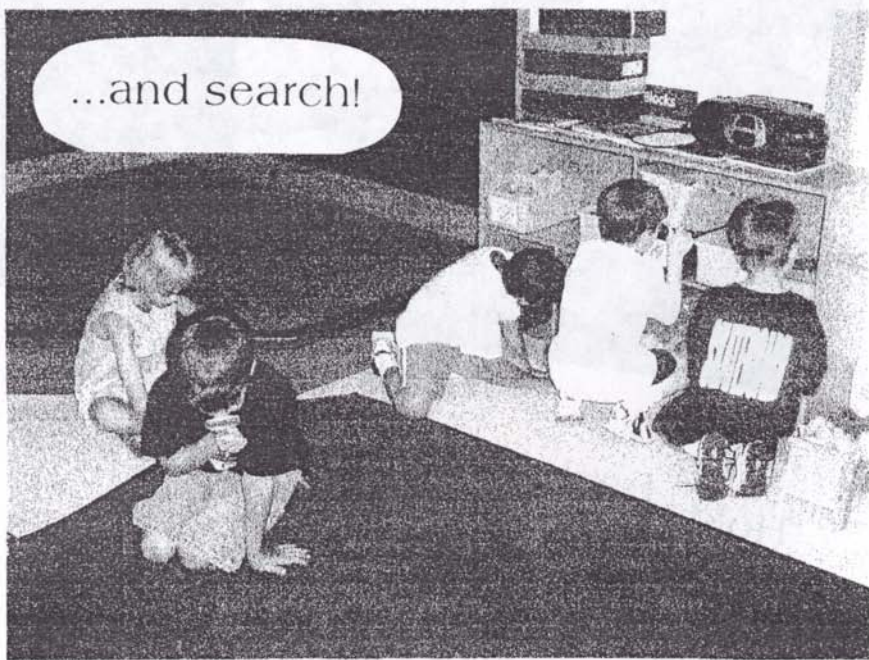

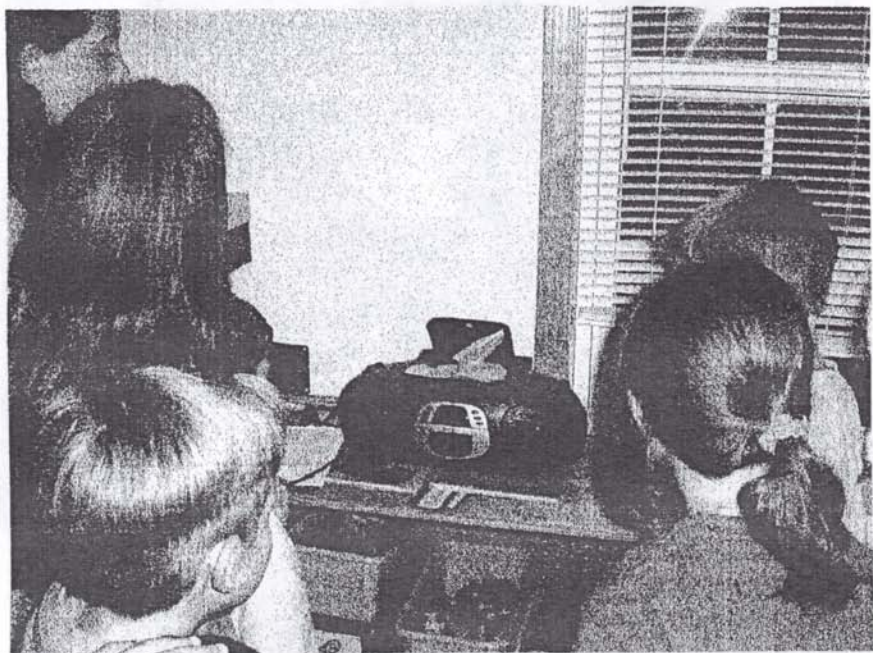


Hmm... They wondered about this new riddle, perplexed.



"Eureka!" shouted Michael, "I've got it, guys! C and D! The CD player!"

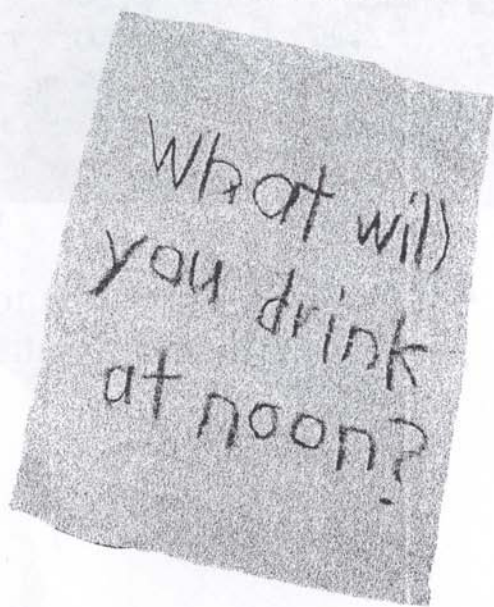




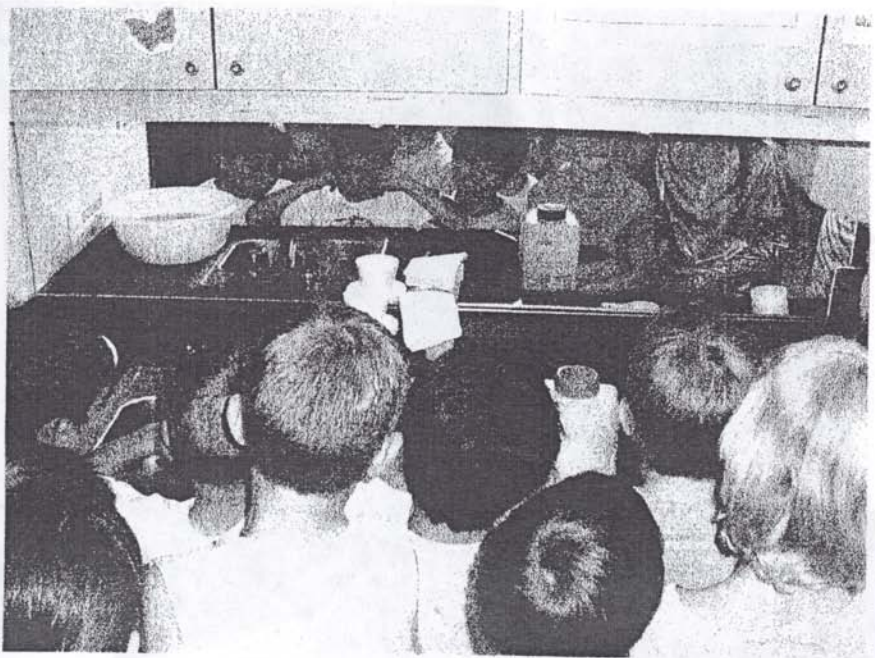
They all ran straight to the CD player  
and discovered another note.



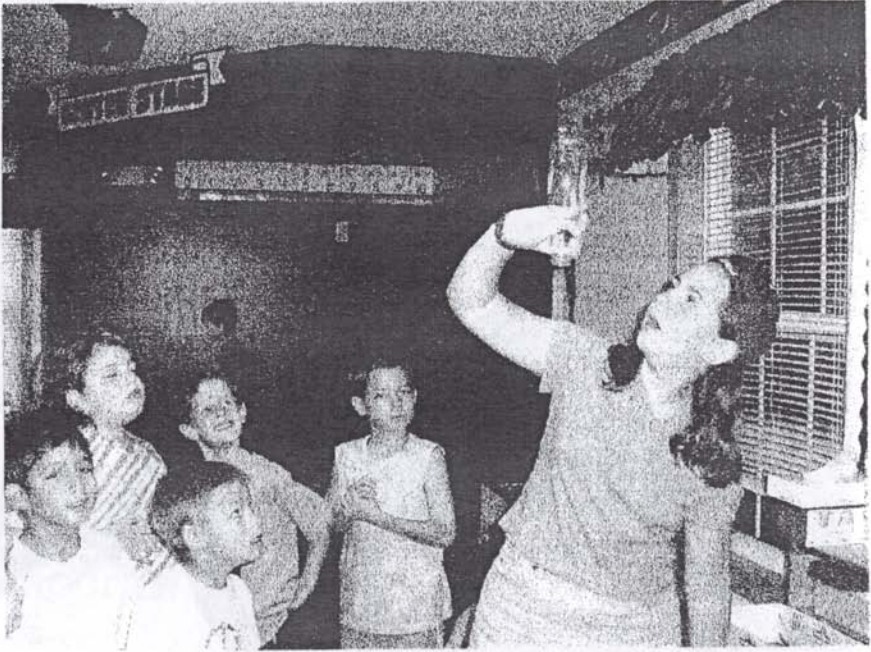
“Ah...” Everyone sighed, “Another clue!”

They went to the sink, looking for a jug of milk. They could find no jug, nor another note.

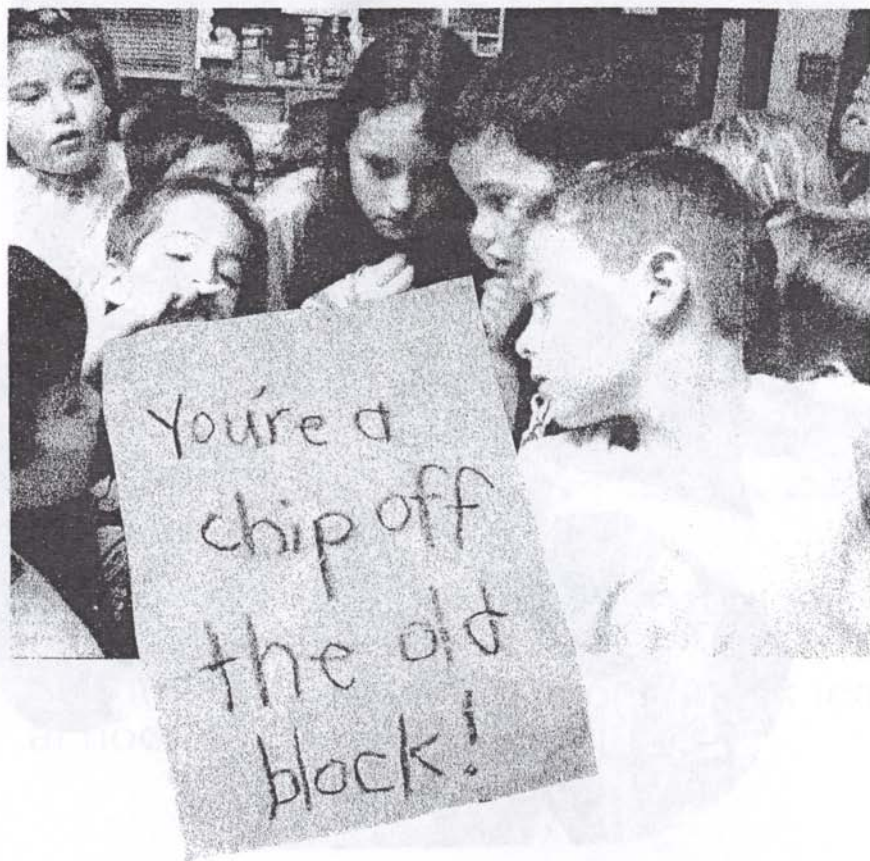


They went to the play kitchen, but still could not find the next letter. "What about tea!" Scott said, "People drink tea at noon in London!"

four minutes past noon!



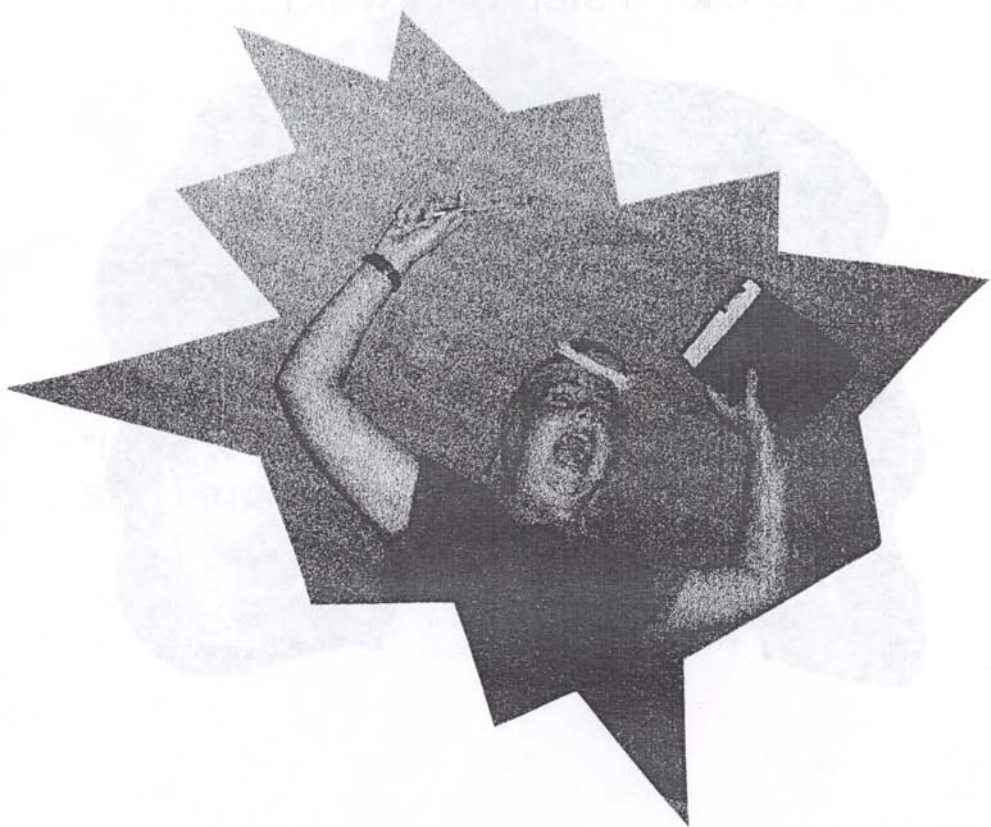


"I knew you would never find it in time!"
