

paces North...

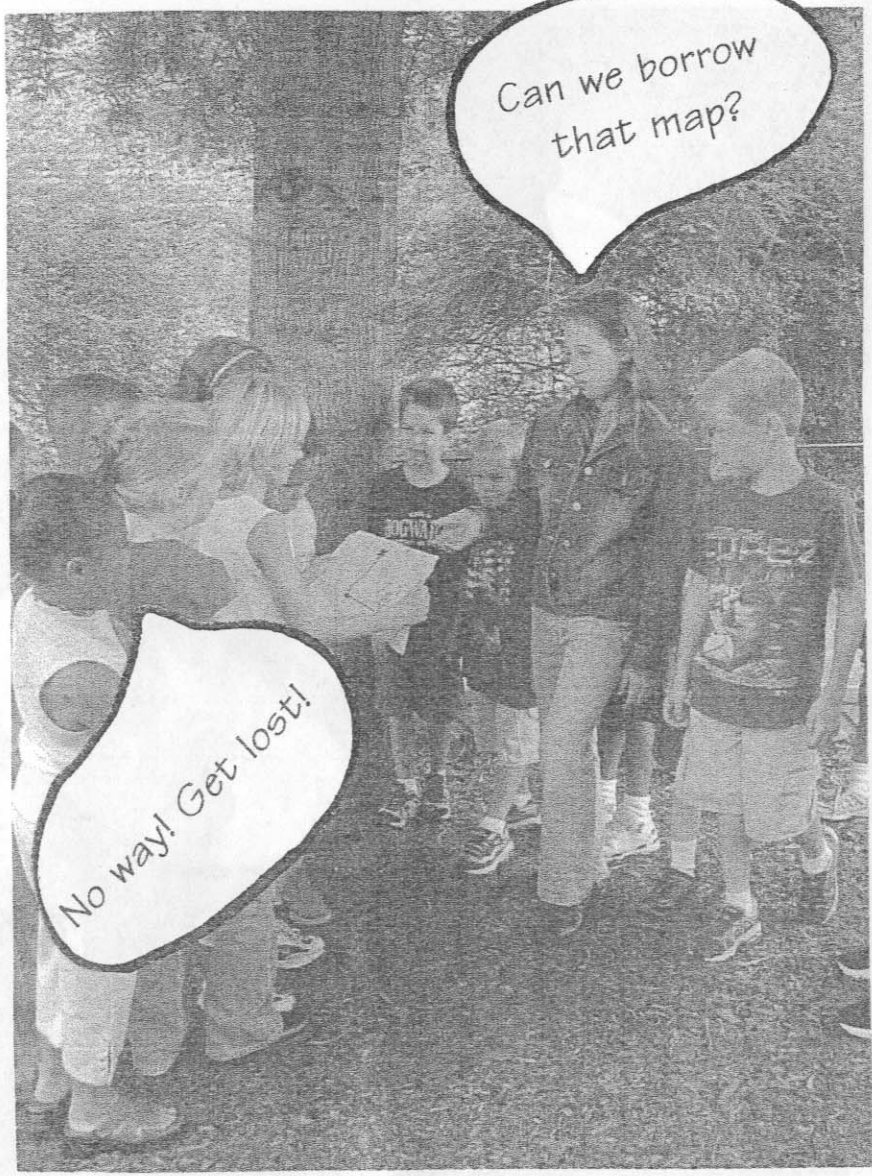
The map

We'll be back!



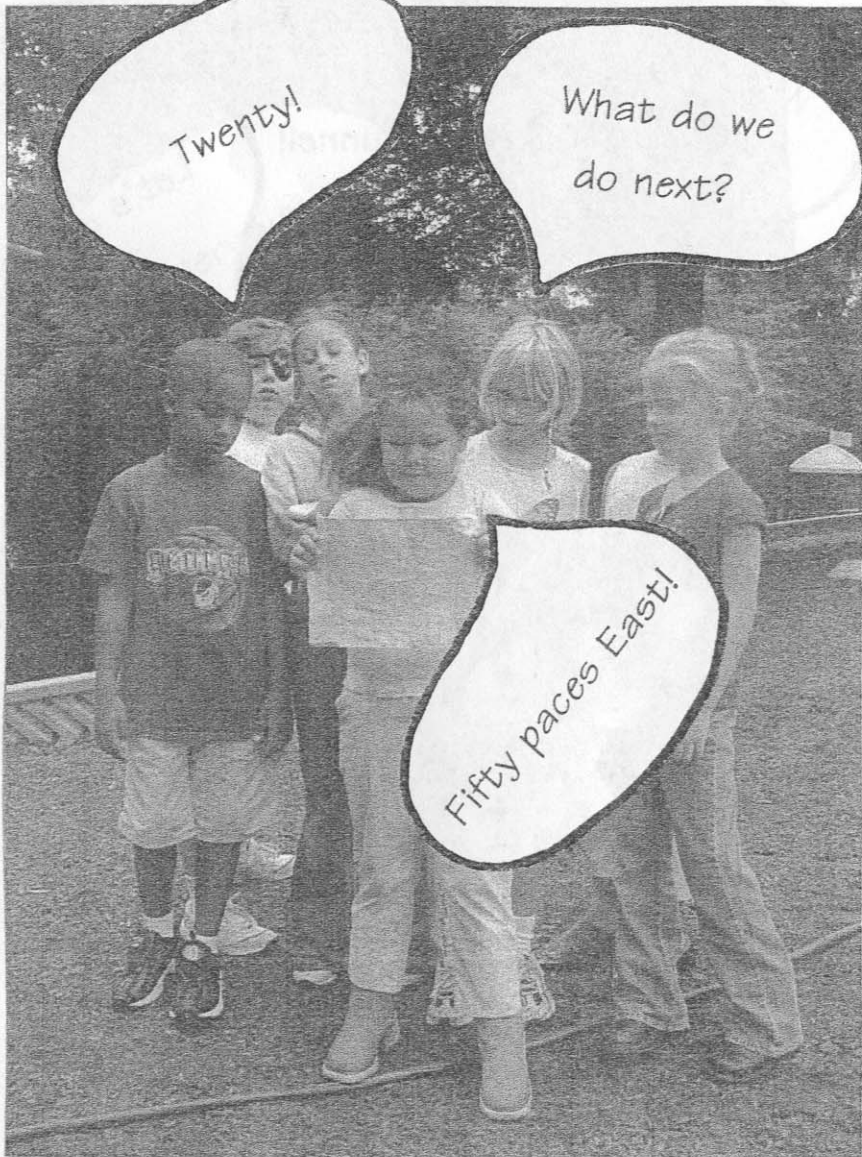
They were weird!

gone.


I think we're

a door!

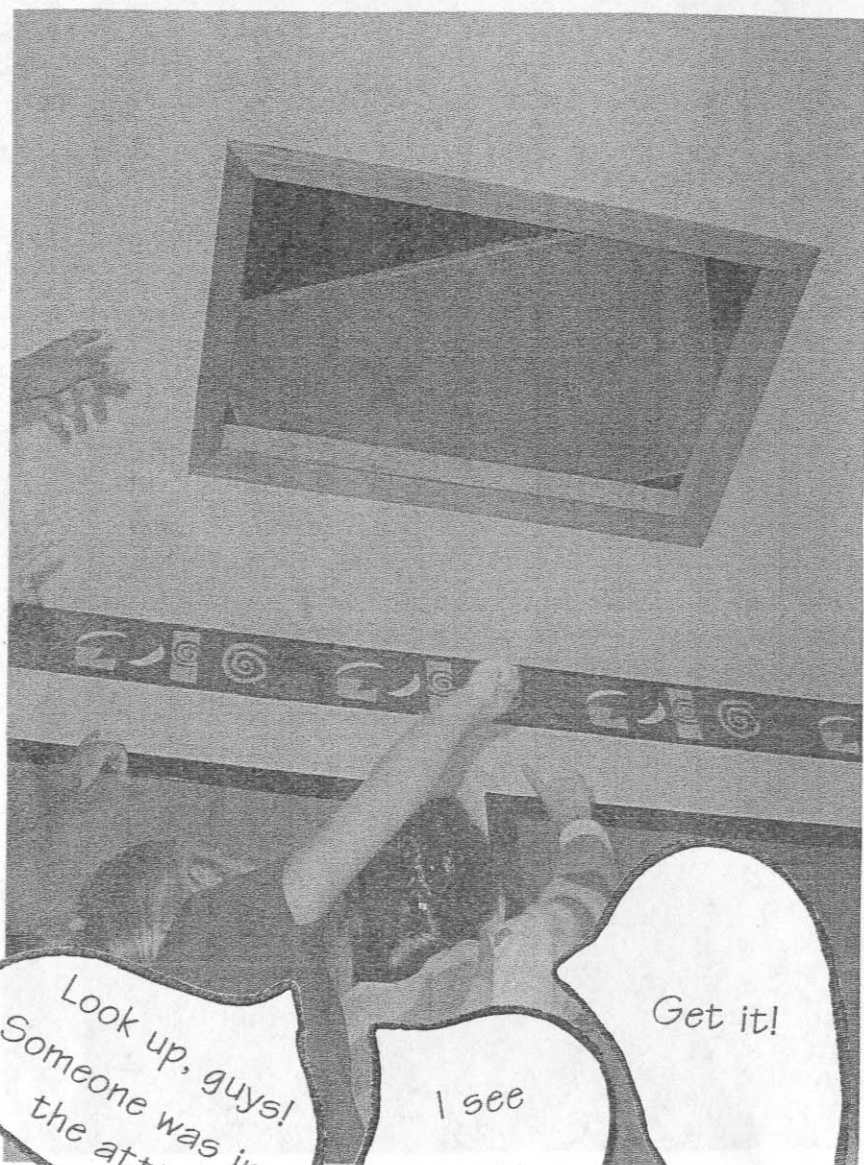
Open it!

classroom!

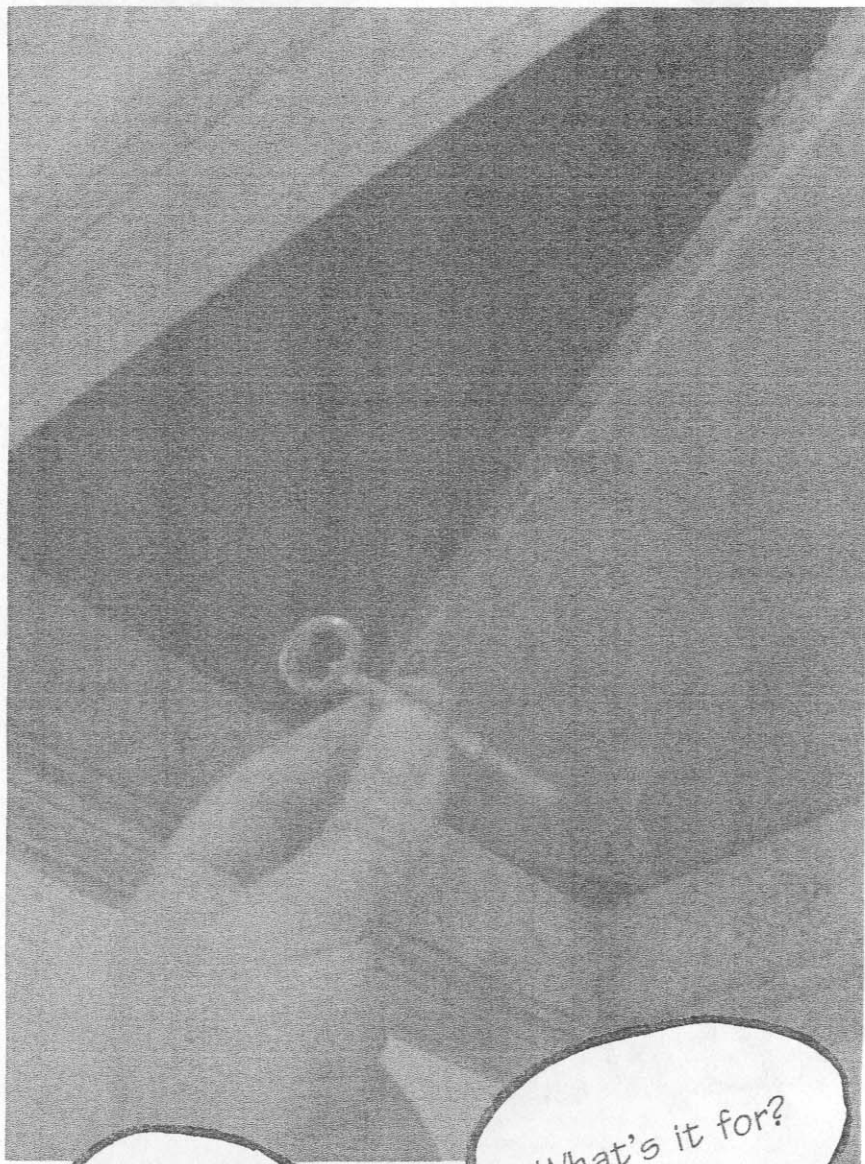
How did that

the attic!


I see

computer cabinet.






Look in the
