Wiring is dependant upon type of existing coin mech and timer. Begin by determining whether your coin mech has 3 wires hooked up (Hot, Neutral and Coin Signal) or a 4 wire hook up (Hot, Neutral, Coin + and Coin -). You may find that your 4 wire coin mech has 2 wires twisted together....this is a "3 wire" style hook up.

Test with bill....if no credit is shown on timer then tie the Green or Orange wire to the White instead of the Black. Test with a bill....if no credit shown call us for help.

Depending upon the timer(s), display and other devices used, an isolation device (such as a Ginsan GS-17) may be required for proper operation.
