April y^e 7th 1772.

At a Lawfull Town Meeting held in North Castle On Tuesday the Seventh of April by the West and Middle Patents to choose and Elect Town Officers and make such prudential acts as said Pattents or the Inhabitants thereof hath power and shall think proper to do.

As Follows Viz.

Gilbert Thorn, Clerk. David Dayton Esq^r Supervisor. Andrew Merritt Constable to serve all Summonses and Subpeanies for the Inhabitants of said North Castle for one shilling each. Benjamin Kipp Esq^r his Security for his performance. Andrew Merritt also Collector for s^d North Castle. David Hobby and John Sarles, Sessors. Gilbert Palmer and Joseph Cornell Trustees and overseers of the Poor and to make

up the Quit Rent. James Miller being Chosen Vestryman by the town of Rye, the town of North Castle Endemnifies him for not acting. Samuel Baker, Archelaws Carpenter and Andrew Sniffin, Pounders, fence viewers, and Prisers of Damages. Timothy Carpenter, overseer of the road from Red brook down to the Colony line, thence to the middle of the Bridge by Thomas Weeks's. Stephen Vorhis overseer of the road from red brook up to Samuel Holmes's and the cross road to Chesnut Ridge. John Pine overseer of the road from Bedford line to the Middle Pattent. Abram Knapp overseer of the road from Bedford line to the Colony line and to Budsons Mill. David Hobby overseer of the road from the Colony Line to Bedford and the cross roads, the one east and the other west. David Peck overseer of

the roads, or all the rest of the roads in the Middle Patent. Samuel Baker overseer of the road from the middle of the Long bridge by Thomas Weeks's so down as usual to the Colony line and the road near the Quaker Meeting house. John Green overseer of the road from the red house of Tho^s Wrights, so north to Bedford line, and the road to Sam^l Cheesemans. Frances Quimby overseer of the road from Thomas Wrights up to Barzilla Carpenters and the cross road from the mouth of the lane. Caleb Haight overseer of the road from John Wrights to the Crotch of the road by Nathaniel Brundages. John Powel overseer of the road from Brunkes's River by John Niles, so to Samuel Bakers. William Seaman overseer of the cross road by his house. Reuben Wright overseer of the road from Andrew Purdys to Brunks River by Henry Feeks so to said river by Jeremy Woods. James Miller overseer of the road from Brunks River by Henry Feeks so to the White Plains Line and the cross roads there including. James Leggett overseer of the road from Bedford Line by Charles Hights, and thence the cross road by the Bridge called the roaring bridge, thence from James Hights westward to Phillips line two roads thence northward to Jessee Kipps, and thence from Joseph Carpenters to the Quaker Meeting house. James (Leggett) Weeks overseer of the Road from and including the Bridge called Roaring Bridge to Benjamin Smiths Jn^r thence southward to Jessee Kipps, and thence to the Meeting House, with the hands as usual. Robert Lounsbury overseer of the road from Benjamin Smiths Jn^r to Courtlands line by Solomon Hunt, thence by Bedford line, thence Thomas Vantasels down to the Roaring brook so called, thence from said Lounsburies northward to Courtlands line. Isaac Jerow overseer of the road from Benjamin Smiths to Phillips line, thence Northward to Courtlands Line. Caleb Fowler Esq^r Overseer of the road from Samuel Devenports down to Phillips Line and the cross road to Caleb Hights. Benjamin Tillison overseer of the road above Gabriel Purdys

Caleb Haight overseer of the same road as he was the year last Past. Thomas Baker overseer of the same road as he was the year last past. Prior Feeks overseer of the same road as W^m Seaman the year last past. Jeremiah Hunter overseer of the same road as he was the year last past. Jacob Purdy overseer of the same road as he was the year last past. Archelaus Carpenter overseer of the road from Bedford Line by Charles Hights down to Robert Dickensons house thence to Phillips Line Annias Mathus. Elnathan Thorn overseer of the road from Robert Dickensons to the Quaker Meeting house, thence to Jessee Kipps, thence again southward - two roads - to Phillips line. Abraham Carpenter overseer of the road that Benjamin Smith Jun^r was the year past. James Barnes overseer of the same road as Nathaniel Smith was the last year past. Richard

Tompkins overseer of the road from Benjamin Smiths Jun^r to Phillips Line thence northeast to Courtlandts Line. Richard Washburn overseer of the road from Jessee Kipps so to Samuel Hallocks Mill. Caleb Fowler Jun^r over of the same road as Henry Fowler was last year past. Benjamin Tillison overseer of the same road that he was the last year past.

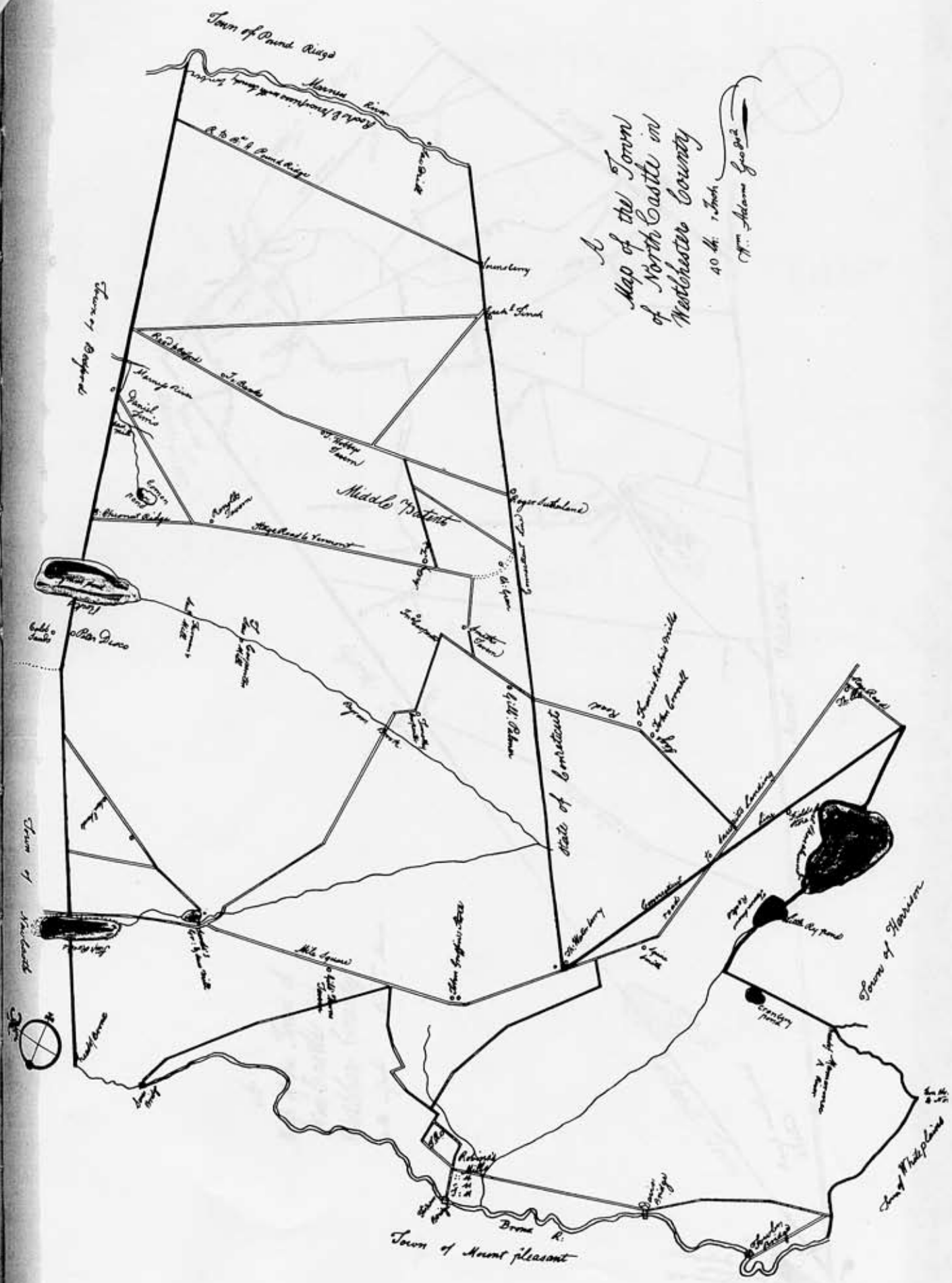

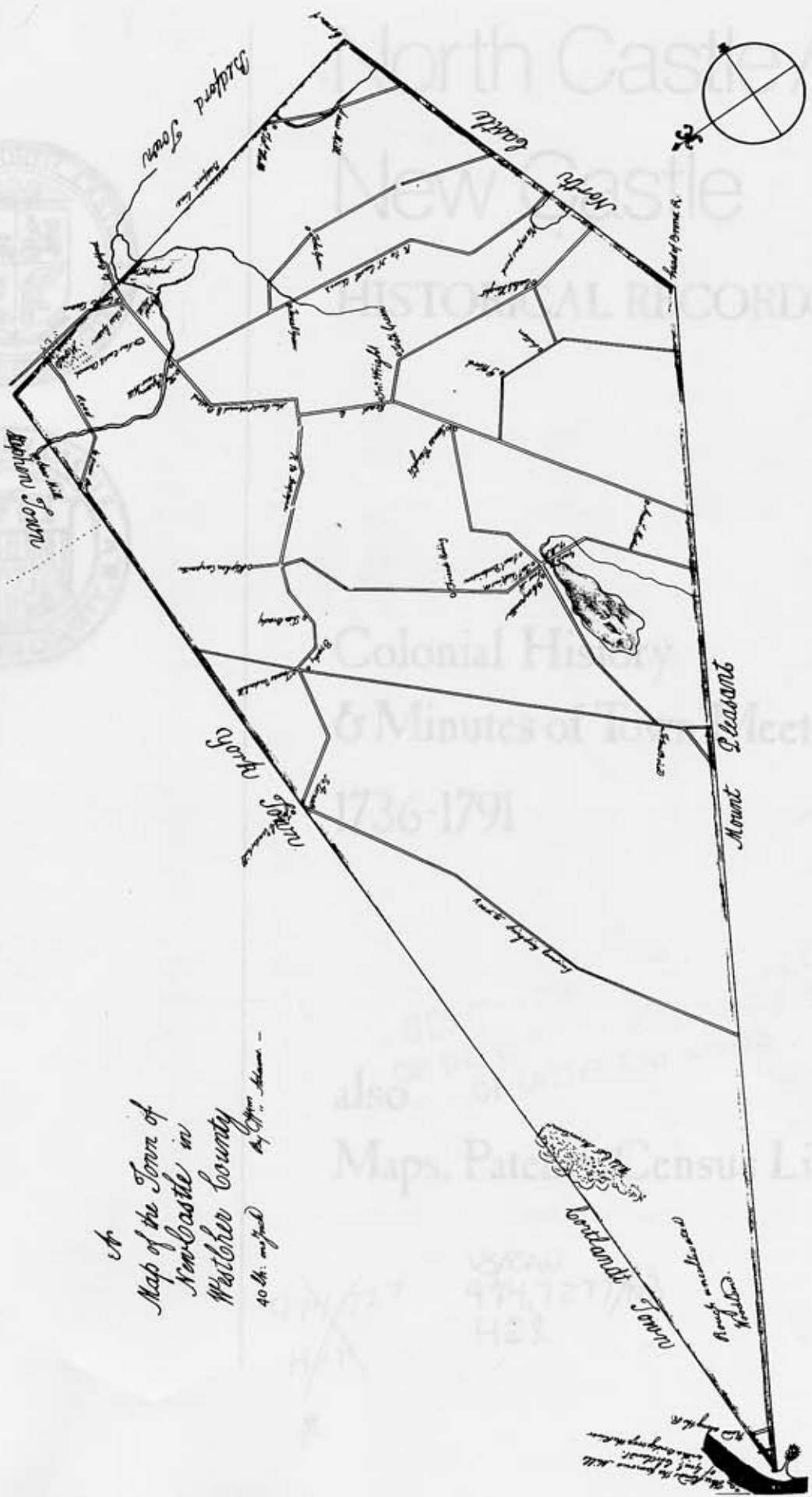
