

CHIP CHARTS

CHIP CHARTS (IN YARDS)

Note: Chips are measured on flat surface. To have accurate chips consider the elevation to the green. E.G. 42 yards to hole and hole is 9 feet above ball, you would want to hit it 45 yards. (3ft = 1yd). The slope of the green would also affect your chip. Down slope chip shorter. Upslope chip a bit more. Also the Advanced shot setup can vary your distances by moving the ball Forward or Backward, as noted on chip charts.
