

Plymouth Colony Ancestral Homes

Home of Thomas Prence (1600-1673), Eastham, built 1646, no longer standing




Home of Zachariah Paddock (1636-1727), Yarmouth, built 1666, still standing




Home of John Dillingham (1630-1715), Yarmouth jurisdiction (now Brewster), built 1659, still standing




Home of John Kingsley (1614-1678), Rehoboth, built 1669, still standing but altered
