David WATTLES participated in the Battle of White Plains on 28 October 1776 and in the Battle of Trenton on 26 December 1776.
09. **Samuel WATTLES (1729-178-)**: CT Minutemen (Tilden's Lebanon Company; Mason's Lebanon Company); Putnam's / Storrs's 3rd Regt CT Line; crew of ship "Oliver Cromwell" (CT) (Corporal); Sherburne's Continental Regt; Van Rensselaer's 8th Regt Albany Co (NY) Militia (Sergeant); Whiting's 17th Regt Albany Co (NY) Militia (Sergeant). Jeremiah Mason's Company of Minutemen – to which Samuel WATTLES belonged – "performed a tour of duty at the siege of Boston, and was with the party that was sent out in the early part of the night to fortify Dorchester Heights" on 4 March 1776.
