

# DESCENT FROM LAWRENCE SOUTHWICK AND HIS WIFE CASSANDRA BURNELL, OF KINGSWINFORD, STAFFORDSHIRE, AND SALEM, MASSACHUSETTS

“Lawrence, Cassandra, and their son Josiah and daughter Mary, were fined, whipped, imprisoned and finally banished for being Quakers; and their son Daniel and daughter Provided were sentenced by the General Court to be sold into slavery. Lawrence and Cassandra went to Shelter Island, Long Island Sound, having been banished under pain of death from Massachusetts in 1659. They died there in Spring of 1660 from privation and exposure, Cassandra dying just 3 days after Lawrence.”
