

## Guideline for Citing Sources in ISLAS

### References:

All references should appear at the end of the complete text, under the category NOTES. Only small (not superscript) numbers should appear in the actual text. Any kind of reference or endnote number should be done manually and not using a computer footnote or endnote function. Whenever possible, please situate these numbers at the end of sentences.

### Notes:

In the NOTES, after the end of the entire text, the same number that corresponds to the note in the text should appear as a normally sized (not superscript).

### EXAMPLE:

#### Citing a book:

In *Ecué-Yamba-O* Alejo Carpentier portrays the experience of a rural black man when he goes to Havana.

Carpentier, Alejo. *Ecué-Yamba-O*. Madrid: Alianza, 2002: 33. (Please note that the book's title is in italics and is not underlined. If the book has more than one author, the rest of the names appear after the first one in their normal order).

#### Citing an article:

2- Cuesta Morúa, Manuel. "Cuba: The Racism We Have Within." *ISLAS* 6: 2 (May

2007): 23. (When there are multiple authors, the rest of the names appear after the first one in their normal order).

#### Citing a book chapter:

3- Rivera Nieves, Irma. "Desencantamientos postmodernos: la borradura de los márgenes." In *Globalización, nación, postmodernidad*, eds. Luis Felipe Díaz and Marc Zimmerman. San Juan, PR: Ediciones La Casa 2001, 1988. 125-43. (When there are multiple authors, the rest of the names appear after the first one in their normal order).

#### Citing an article from an electronic source:

#### Citing a previously cited work:

5- Carpentier, Alejo. Op.cit: 13. (Include the page number if the reference is not to the same previously cited page or work. If there is already a previous citation to the same page, work, and author, please write—Ibid).
