

# P.L.U.T.O. RESCUE SPAY/NEUTER PROGRAM

## INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS

(Please read completely)

1. The recommended age for spay/neutering is **2-6 MONTHS** of age. Female animals should be spayed before their first heat (estrus cycle). They DO NOT need to have a litter before spaying.

2. DO NOT MAKE AN APPOINTMENT with the veterinarian UNTIL YOU HAVE RECEIVED THE SPAY/NEUTER CERTIFICATE. You **must have the certificate** to give to the vet when the animal is admitted for spay/neutering.

3. The P.L.U.T.O. certificate covers the cost of a routine spay/neuter procedure including pre-exams, anesthesia, surgical procedure, waste disposal, post-operative care, hospitalization as required, and such removal if necessary.

4. Inoculations are the responsibility of the pet owner and may be required by the vet.

5. The vet may charge the pet owner additional fees for non-routine procedures such as:

- Pre-diagnosed infections
- animals in estrus cycle (heat)
- dogs 50 lbs and over
- undescended testicles
- pregnancy
- age (older animals)

**Ask the vet about any additional charges before the spay/neuter procedure is performed.** All services requested unrelated to a

routine spay/neuter procedure are the responsibility of the pet owner.

6. Certificate expires **six months** after date of issue. **Refund Policy:** \$10 service fee will be deducted from refunded certificates. **NO REFUNDS made after two months from date of issue.**

7. Fill out the order form completely, indicating animals type and sex, and mail your payment with a self-addressed, stamped envelope to:

9. Upon receipt of your order and payment, P.L.U.T.O. will process the order and you will receive your certificate within approximately 1-2 weeks.
