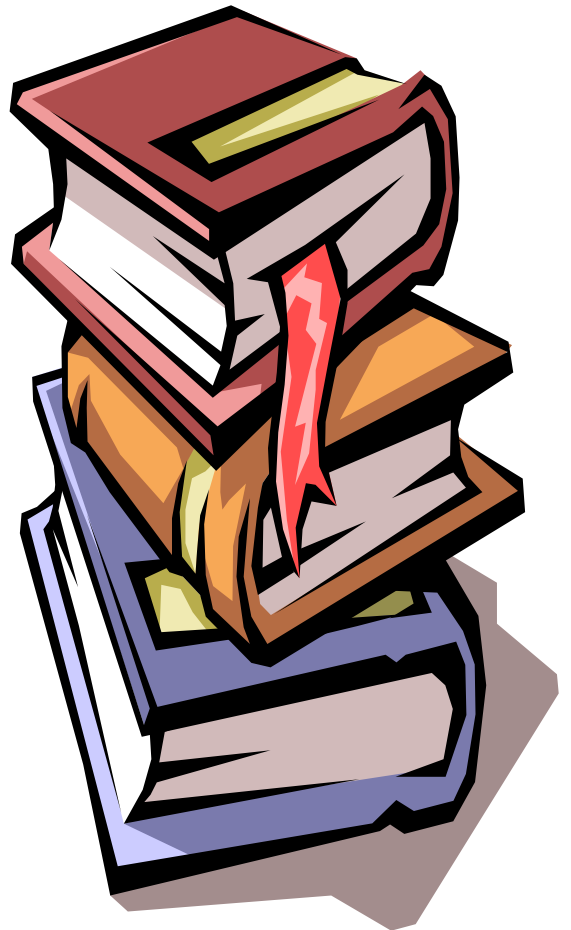

THE SIMPLE TRUTH

There's a chance that 20% of the people you see day to day cannot read. More than 10,000 adults in the Tri-State area have never finished the 8th grade. Someone you care about may have trouble reading. A lot of the things we take for granted are difficult for some people.

There are people who cannot:

- Fill out a job application
- Adapt to job changes
- Handle personal business
- Read letters or recipes
- Read the Bible or a ballot
- Read medicine labels
- Read a story to their child or grandchild

Many people live each day of their lives in fear of being discovered. Although they are afraid or ashamed to ask for help; many adults can and do learn to read.

Those who failed to learn to read as children (for whatsoever reason) can find help thorough the Tri-State Literacy Council (TSLC). The TSLC is a volunteer adult literacy program where tutors and students work together. There are a variety of supplemental materials and techniques that have been designed to help adults.
