The RCAF Unit Commendation may be given to any formation, unit, sub-unit, group or team within the Canadian Armed Forces, or to any unit, sub-unit, group or team within an allied force or civilian organization.

Recipients will have worked within, or in conjunction with, the RCAF, and performed a deed or activity of a high standard considered beyond the demand of normal duty. Their contributions and service will have benefitted and brought great credit to the RCAF.

The RCAF Unit Commendation is administered by the RCAF at the Directorate Air Personnel Management.
