 - b) Afrasiyab
- 4. Who are the Amesha Spentas? Describe their genesis and cosmic roles.
- 5. Describe Khshathra Vairya before and after evil learned about its existence.
- 6. In what way was Plato's society under the guardian the same as the Persians' social structure under the Ahuric order? In what way were the two different?
- 7. Describe the role of the *farr* (various levels) in Iranian society and culture.
- 8. Explain the PreSocratics' view of the "first principle" and describe the significance of the first principle.
- 9. Discuss causes and categories in Aristotle's approach to understanding nature.
- 10. Describe "Allegory of the Cave" and its significance.
- 11. Describe the Magams or Stages in Sufism.
- 12. What role did translation play in the development of the medieval world?
- 13. Who are the Mu'tazilites? Describe their impact on the Islamic world.
- 14. Discuss the influence of Zoroastrianism on Twelvers Shi'ite Islam.
- 15. Describe the impact of al-Ghazzali's efforts on the Muslim world.
- 16. Describe the daily schedule, as well as the clothing, travel, and social status of a person living in Sir Thomas More's Utopia.
- 17. To whom, or to what, in the former Soviet Union, might the following names from *Animal Farm* apply: Squealer; Snowball; Moses; the Windmill?
