Hull/Deck Finish and Construction.- Solid fibreglass hull, finished in Dark Blue "Awl Grip" or equal. In Good condition. Deck is fibreglass, with selected areas cored with balsa. Waterline is painted. There is no significant structural or aesthetic damage to the hull and deck. There are no signs of delamination or blistering.

Underwater Condition.-When examined in spring of 2003 it was in good condition and free of damage and or blistering. New antifouling paint has been applied
