### "Praise"

On January 8, 2006 we had Rev. Jonathan Atkins at the Cleveland Church. His wife, Kristen and son Jonathan David II were with him also. He preached at both services and his main topic was "PRAISE". He really brought a stirring to the saints.

After he got through Sunday night my arms were sore, my toes hurt as well as both feet. This preacher actually had the audacity to have the congregation to stand and clap almost throughout the whole sermon(s). He even asked, no demanded, that we clap our hands for at least fifteen 'SECONDS". Can you imagine that? In my mind I thought back to other times when someone would ASK the people to give a handclap of praise and I counted the times "I" would do it and only come up with 6 or 7 times, and I seemed please. I felt my flesh becoming offended by the GALL of this man ordering us to do that much clapping and standing. He said sometimes we just give "lip service" to God, when He wants us to SHOW Him.

As if the morning sermon on Praise wasn't enough, he came back in the night service with, "When God is Silent, What do you do?". He took his text from Matthew 15:21-28, keying on verses 23 and 25. (I'm not trying to re-preach his message, just telling how God dealt with MY issues about the message.) His point was that "sometimes" God wants PRAISE and WORSHIP before He speaks to us.

My mind, again, went back to a time when I worked in a stove foundry operating large presses that punched holes in the steel being worked to make stove parts. Sometimes there were 3 or 4 persons working on one press. For safety reasons the control buttons were mounted above the work area to keep everyone's hands out of the press. I remember some days when I was dealing with spirits in my mind, I would say, "Praise the Lord", "Thank you Jesus", or other words of praise. About the 5th or 6th time raising my hands on the buttons I would begin to feel the Spirit and begin to speak in other tongues and the other men would have to wait for me to get back. Fortunately they were from other churches and they didn't complain.

The bottom line of this story is that we have gotten away from spontaneous worship. We mostly wait to be prodded and wonder why God does not speak to us like He used to. I think it is time to SHOW God that we are different from the rest of the world, and quit trying to tell the world how different we are. Can I get a big AMEN?
