After waiting anxiously the litter was finally being born on August 31, 2004. By around 4:00 PM that afternoon all eight were here and both mom and babies were doing well at Billie's house in Smithville, TX. Then around midnight Maghia began to get nervous, anxious and fidgety and low and behold out came one more! They were named after magical terms (with two exceptions) since both sire and dam were from magical litters and using a name generator online based on the Elfish language from Lord of the Rings their names were turned into the elfish language. The exceptions of course was that last one whose name in English was "Midnight Surprise," which when translated to Elfish became "Glorfindel", his birthday is technically September 1<sup>st</sup> since he was born after midnight, so we could have a two day celebration! The second exception was Maglor who was the smallest of the litter so we called him "Tiny Tim" in English!

She was also major pointed and earned 8 points towards her AKC Championship title! Tara was also BOS at a LSBC match, and WB, BOW at the LSBC TSE for her major, in Houston.

Amras was the first of the Elfish litter to title earning his AKC Championship title at 17 months. Along the way to his Grand Championship title he earned many Group placement wins to numerous to list. He was also in the top Borzoi rankings for a number of years and earned his AKC Senior Courser title along the way. Truly a multi talented dog with two of the best owners!





Borchi's Tathar Numenesse, SC, "Tex" has been Amras' lifelong companion going to Brighton, TN and living with Elizabeth Tolley & David Nutting there. Tathar's name in English stands for "Illusion!" He got his call name from the white spot on the back of his neck which is in the shape of Texas! Betsy and David coursed him and earned his AKC Senior Courser title!
