

PFA 099 Course Syllabus
Fall, 2001

Course Description:

This is a non-instructive course that requires attendance at concerts, recitals, and theater productions by PFA and Music Majors.

Course Goals:

Each Performing Arts or Music Major should be actively involved in performance, both participating and observing. This course ensures attendance and encourages critical thinking and analysis of performance style and quality in a variety of idioms.

Course Requirements:

Seven performances are required this semester in the following areas:

- Orchestra
- Choir
- Theater
- Voice

Three additional performances are required though the type of performance is left to the student. Two of these performances must be sponsored by the SVU Performing Arts or Music Programs.

Grading Procedures:

Grading for this course is Pass/Fail. All 7 performances are required to pass the class. A program from the performance must be placed in the PFA 099 envelope outside of Dr. Bradshaw's office (Hilltop #5) no more than one week after the performance. Programs will not be accepted late. Please write your name legibly on the front of the program or you will not receive credit for the performance. Also indicate the type of performance you would like it to count for if there is more than one possibility. You may check your record periodically with Dr. Bradshaw. For approval of questionable events, see Dr. Bradshaw.
