Objectives

This course is designed to give the student a working knowledge of the International Phonetic Alphabet and to develop in them the necessary skills to apply IPA to the English, and Italian languages. These skills will be demonstrated in the following manner:

- Given a text in English or Italian, the student will demonstrate a working knowledge of The International Phonetic Alphabet by transcribing the text into IPA.

- c. Given a text in Italian the student will read it aloud without an IPA transcription.
- d. The student will demonstrate the application of these skills to singing by performing pieces in English and Italian from an approved list of pieces during scheduled class time.
