This Month's Topic: Choosing a Digital projector



Monterey Squid Dive



Dolphin Divers of Sacramento are having a squid dive in Monterey! The best time to find spawning squid is during a rising full moon in May or June. Based on his advice the Cypress Sea is chartered for two dives the night of Saturday, May 21. Moonrise is at 6:00 so this looks like perfect timing for our dives. We are boarding at 7:00 and returning to the dock at 11:00. This is an incredible experience but you need advanced skills to cope with a couple of deeper night dives. Nitrox is recommended, but air is OK. Both are available on the boat, or you can bring your own. The cost is only \$70.00 for this unique experience. This trip will be limited to 16 divers.
