

Dale graduated with the class of 1959 with a GPA of 2.90. Dale was a three-sport athlete, accumulating ten varsity letters at Eastmont. Two in Football, four in Basketball and four in Baseball. Dale was selected to be team Captain in Basketball in 1958 and again in 1959. He was also selected Captain in Baseball in 1959. He was named Basketball Player of the year two times, once in 1957-58 and again in 1958-1959. In his Senior year, Dale was selected as a 1st team All State Center Fielder from the Regional Central Washington All-Star Baseball game and played in the State vs. City game at Sick's Stadium in Seattle, WA. In addition to being highly involved in Athletics, Dale served as Junior Class President in 1957-58. He was selected ASB Vice President in 1958-59. After high school, Dale went on to play Baseball at Wenatchee Valley College where he lettered in both Basketball and Baseball in 1959-60 and 1960-61. Dale was selected All Conference Center Fielder both years as well.




