Elizabeth Dunn Robinson's death certificate shows her mother was also named Elizabeth. The same document gives her father's name as Thornton Dunn. The 1880 Census shows Thornton Dunn living in Lincoln County with his family which consisted of a wife, Milta, and four children ranging in ages from Ten to nineteen. The names of the children were Thornton (age 19), a fifteen year old female, Francis (age 13) and Mary (age 10). The census records also show Thornton Dunn was a mulatto who was born in Louisiana around 1809. No other written reference was found on Elizabeth's mother.

Notes for VICTORIA "SISSY" ROBINSON:

Following the death of Thornton Edgar Robinson in October 1933, the Lincoln County Chancery Court disposed of the property once owned by their deceased mother, Elizabeth Robinson, in 1934. Their mother had died on 19 October 1926. The disposition of the property was NO. 7213. The disposition reads as follows with a few minor corrections of the original document:

"In the matter of the petition of the lands of the Estate of Elizabeth Robinson - deceased - Victoria Robinson - Narsis Robinson et als - Ex Partee - Petitioners -- etc."

"This cause coming on for hearing on report of the Special Commissioners appointed by the court in this cause same being John Erwin, Levi or L. L. Red and Robert Clark, and said report being joined in by all of the parties to this cause, said being Victoria Robinson, Narsis Robinson adults, and also the following children of Narsis Robinson who come by their mother as next friend as follows - to - wit: - Mary Robinson - E. J. Robinson - Silas Robinson - Tycer Robinson - Willie Robinson - Eddis Marea Robinson, minors - the said Narsis Robinson and her children are to have the interest of their deceased husband and father of said children sane being Thornton E. Robinson, deceased, and the other interest being Victoria Robinson, she being the sister of the said Thornton E. Robinson".

"The said report shows that the commissioners met at the residence of the parties which is located on the lands that were partited and before beginning their work took and subscribed the required oath, and then proceeded to divide the lands described in said decree as directed in the said decree - the land as described in said decree being as follows to-wit: South 1/2 of the South West 1/4 Section 23, less 14 acres on the west side, and 16 acres on the North side of the North west 1/2 Section 26, all in Township 5, Range 7 East, and containing 82 acres more or less - and the decree directed that said ands be divided into two equal parts as to its value not considering the value of the house located on said lands, and that the lands on which the said house or residence is located was to be given to the heirs of Thornton E. Robinson, deceased, and the other lands to be given to said Victoria Robinson, the said heirs of Thornton E. Robinson to share equally with the said Victoria Robinson as to the value of the said land etc-"

"The report shows that the commissioners allotted to Victoria Robinson of the above lands the following ro - wit; -"

"Beginning at a point 462 feet east of the North west corner of the South west 1/4 of the South West 1/4 Section 23, Township 5, Range 7 East and running thence east to the Right-of-way of Highway North 51, thence southly along the west side of said highway to the Section line thence West to a point 462 feet East of the South west corner of the said Section 23, thence North to the place of beginning, also a strip of land beginning at the south west corner of the above described lands and running thence southly to the new gravel road, thence easterly along the north side of the said new road to the highway, thence along the west side of said Highway north 51 northly to the section line between sections 23, and 26, thence west to the place of beginning, and said strip of land being in the North half of the north west 1/4 of Section 26, and containing in both of the above descriptions 14 acres more or less - also the following described lands - beginning at a point where the North line SW, of SW1/4 Section 23 crosses Highway North 51 and running thence southly along the east side of said highway to a point 50 feet south of the south end of the bridge over the creek, thence easterly across said creek, thence easterly along the center of the creek to where the creek to where the creek crosses the east side of the South East 1/4 of South west 1/4 making the center of the creek the line on the south, thence north to the north east corner, of the South East 1/4 of South west 1/4 thence west across the north boundary line of the South East 1/4 of South West 1/4 to north west corner of said quarter section , thence West to the place of beginning and containing 25 acres more or less, and being all the lands north of the center of the creek and east of the Highway North 51 including 50 feet south of the south end of the bridge

over the creek, and west of the creek and east of said highway - Section 23, all in Township 5 Range 7 East, and containing in all 39 acres more or less- The following lands were allotted to the heirs of Thornton E. Robinson, deceased, same being his wife Narsis Robinson, Mary Robinson, Willie Robinson, E. J. Robinson - Silas Robinson - Tyser Robinson, and Eddis Mariah Robinson - - - - All that part of the south west 1/4 of South west 1/4 that lies south of the center of the creek and east of Highway North 51 less 50 feet south of the bridge & west of creek and also all that part of the South East 1/4 of South west 1/4 that lies south of the center of the creek Section 23, and containing 30 acres more or less, also the following described lands beginning at the south east corner of the South east 1/4 of South West 1/4 of South West 1/4 and running thence south 264 feet to a stake, thence west to right - of - way of Highway North 51, thence northly along the east side of said highway to the section line between Section 23 and 26, thence east to the place of beginning and containing 13 acres more or less and being in the North 1/2 of the North West 1/4 of Section 26, all in Township 5, Range 7 East- -"

"The lands allotted to the heirs of Thornton E. Robinson the house or residence being located on same as directed in said decree ordering the lands to be parted ect."

"The commissioner and all parties to this report asks that same be approved, allowed and confirmed as has been divided and allotted ect (?). The court having read and considered the said report and being fully advised in the premises is of the opinion that same is just and correct and that same should approved, allowed and confirmed and approved and that the commissioners have carried out the orders of this court in so doing, so it is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed that the report of said commissioners in this cause is accepted, approved and allowed and conformed and the lands as set out in same to said parties is decreed to be their property, and this decree is to be recorded as a muniment of title to the parties to this cause, and the said commissioners are discharged, and the parties to this cause are taxed with the cost in this matter, and the above lands stand charged with same until fully paid."

Notes for ELIZA ROBINSON:

Eliza Robinson was the sister of Ivy Robinson and her death certificate shows she was the daughter of Amanda and Robert (Bob) Robinson. It is believed that Eliza was born around 1863. She was married more than once, maybe three or more times. Pike County marriage records indicate that a John Youngblood married an Elizabeth Robinson on March 23, 1895. Eliza would have been about Thirty-two at the time. Records later show an Eliza Youngblood married J. E. Boney on April 13, 1908. It has not been determined for sure if this Eliza is the same person who was the sister of Ivy Robinson.

Records show that on November 20, 1902, a John Youngblood was lynched by a mob in Pike County near Summit for complicity in murder. This killing is documented in 100 YEARS OF LYNCHINGS By Ralph Ginzburg and an account of the incident leading up to the lynching appeared in the November 20, 1902, issue of the McComb CITY ENTERPRISE. Will McPhay, a black barber was accused of murdering Walter J. McMorris, the night policeman in Summit on or about November 17, 1902, as he was approached on the streets by McMorris to serve a warrant on him for disturbing the peace. The article states in part, "The woods were scoured all night for McPhay by large posses of citizens but no clue could be obtained of his whereabouts". The article goes on to say, "It is reported here tonight that John Youngblood, another bad Negro, was captured by a posse and got lost in the woods". Ginzburg's book shows Youngblood was lynched. It is possible but has not been confirmed that Eliza was once married to this man who was killed by the mob that was searching for the accused murderer of a lawman on that November night in 1902. It appears that at least for the time being, McPhay escaped, but too bad for Youngblood. Eliza's nephew, Thornton Edgar Robinson, was also a barber in Summit later. It is quite likely that he, like Eliza and others in the area at the time, knew for sure about this Youngblood.

Some time prior to 1920, Eliza married Ed Jackson and it is believed that they owned property near Lake Dixie Springs on Highway 51. It is said that Edgar had a baseball field on the property. On March 30, 1929, Eliza married Joe Love following the death of Ed Jackson. She was with Joe until her death in 1951. She is buried in the cemetery at Rocky Point Missionary Baptist Church in Johnstons Station as is her Husband Joe and many more of her relatives.

Notes for THORNTON EDGAR ROBINSON:

Thornton Edgar Robinson was born on 11 August 1888 in Lincoln County, Mississippi to parents Elizabeth Dunn and Ivy Robinson. Although in addition to his sister Victoria he had other siblings maybe as many as eight others, Edgar was the only male child of Ivy and Elizabeth to survive to reach adulthood.

T. E., as he was also known, was able to read and write. His selective service registration card, which was dated 31 May 1917, described him as being a short black stout man with black eyes and black hair. He was not described as being bald. T. E.'s occupation at the time of his registration was bridge laborer with the Louisiana Division of the Illinois Central Railroad. He was single at the time and he sought exemption from military service because of his dependent mother. About one year later, he married Nasis Bailey.

With some reluctance, T. E. was drafted and went into the army during World War I. It is believed however, that the war may have ended before he saw action. After being discharged from the army, he arrived home after dark one night and surprised his mother Elizabeth, sister Victoria and new wife Nasis.

T. E. had a barber shop in Summit. He along with a neighbor is said to have been detained one night as he was on his way home from the shop by lawmen or a mob in search of a suspected rapist of a white woman. Apparently, the description given by the alleged rape victim was similar to the appearance of T. E. He and his friend were later released the next morning after the alleged rape victim failed to identify him. According to Cousin Luberta, a young black man from Louisiana on his way to a new job in Bogue Chitto, was later accused of the rape and killed by the mob. Documentation to verify this story has not been found.

He passed away following an accident in October 1933 in which he fell from a pile of hay on a wagon being pulled by a mule. The fall from the wagon fractured T. E.'s neck but he lived several days before he died. Zelma Red, a white neighbor, was with T. E. when the accident occurred. Edgar passed away about two months after his forty-fifth birthday.

It was in Milwaukee on 06 June 1988 when Tycer lost his life due to an accident while working on a car in an alley at the home of his brother, Eugene Robinson. A Milwaukee newspaper gives the following account of the incident:

"A 57-year old North Side man was killed last Saturday when the car fell on top of him as he tried to repair the vehicle's muffler, police said.

Tycer Robinson, of 2557 N. 10th St., was pronounced dead at the Milwaukee County Medical Complex just before 11 p. m. 11 p. m. Sunday, the medical examiner's office said.

According to oplice, Robinson had raised the vehicle with a jack but failed to place blocks underneath the car.

Eugene Bailey, 77, of 3714 N. 6th St., told police he was watching Robinson repair the car when the accident occurred.

Bailey told police he tried to use the jack to raise the vehicle again but was unable to do so."
